Direct Service Programs

Senior Food Program

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) distributed **19,898** nutritional boxes of food to our Senior Citizens in 2022. We are looking forward to growing this program more in the coming year!



Childhood Hunger Relief Program

Along with our generous sponsors, Shared Harvest distributed **80,839** weekend bags of food to children in school districts throughout our five county service area in SW Ohio.

SNAP Outreach

Our Help Center assisted **871** families apply for SNAP benefits, providing **716,145** meals.

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program can provide nine meals for every one we provide.



Distributions & Foodbanking

In 2022, Shared Harvest hosted **142 Drive-Thru Distributions**, distributing **1.4 million** pounds of food throughout Butler, Darke, Miami, Preble, and Warren counties.



Total pounds distributed, including our more than **100** member agencies, increased by **3%** to **8.1 Million pounds!**

Resulting in **7.3 Million** meals provided to **347,117** neighbors, comprised of **73,578** seniors and **101,023** children!

We rescued more than **2.9 million** pounds of food in 2022. As a result, we were able to keep those pounds out of a landfill and provide more than **2.5 million** meals.

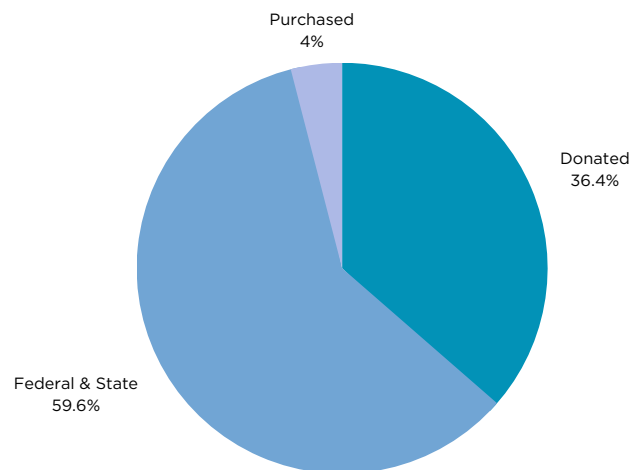
